DESIGN CONSIDERATIONS

The Aiken Horse is a tabloid newspaper with a page size of 11" X 15." It is printed on newsprint using stochastic screening. We do not recommend using four color type in any ads and recommend extreme caution when using knock-out type, especially at sizes below 14 point. 

The Aiken Horse Distribution 2016-2017

The Aiken Horse is a free bimonthly newspaper distributed at tack stores, feed stores and businesses throughout the Aiken-Augusta area. The paper is also available at all major regional equestrian events. It is delivered to local hotels every Thursday, many of which put it in all their rooms. The Greater Aiken Chamber of Commerce and the Aiken Visitors' Center give the paper to visitors interested in the horse world. Numerous local realtors include the paper in their mailings to prospective customers. Large businesses with offices in the area use *The Aiken Horse* as part of the information packet that they send to employees who are relocating to Aiken.

In addition, *The Aiken Horse* is included in the State of South Carolina's tourism program. This means that the paper is available at nine roadside South Carolina Welcome Centers.

Because Aiken has attracted so much interest in the horse world, the paper is in demand across the country. Issues are distributed in tack and feed stores in the equestrian areas of many additional states. We also have subscribers around the country. Some states where we distribute the paper include:
